Thank you for your email.

I do object to the prosecution's application to adjourn the trial. The proposed delay into 2026 is not only prejudicial to me but appears to accommodate a witness whose credibility is already in question.

As you are aware, PC Sudoollah's statement contains multiple contradictions—particularly regarding the alleged assault and the spatial context of the incident. His account conflicts directly with PC Dechamps' own MG11, which describes a reactive arm movement during restraint, not a deliberate assault with intent. Furthermore, Sudoollah claims to have reviewed and exhibited BWV footage (FAS/01), yet the footage has not been disclosed, and the metadata contradicts his own timeline. No corroborating BWV from other attending officers (Dechamps, Cheung, Ward, Afreh-Mensa) has been submitted, nor have their pocket notebooks or timestamped logs.

These omissions breach the CPIA 1996 and undermine the integrity of the prosecution's case. Delaying the trial to accommodate a witness whose evidence is procedurally flawed and potentially fabricated is not in the interests of justice.
