I am formally requesting access to the full audio recording of the 999 call made by Rebecca O'Hare on **2nd August 2025 at 20:36hrs**, logged under **CAD6844/02AUG25**, referenced in the unused material schedule as:

"999 Recording — REDACTED. Audio recording of the emergency 999 call made to police on 2nd AUGUST 20:36hrs by Rebecca O'HARE, reporting that her neighbour has threatened to blow up her car."

This request is made on the following legal and evidential grounds:

🚣 Legal Grounds for Disclosure

- 1. **Contradiction Mapping** The call is cited as foundational to the allegation of threats to cause criminal damage. I need to verify whether the language used aligns with the MG11 statement and whether it supports or contradicts the charge narrative.
- 2. **Procedural Integrity** The same MG11 statement was previously used in a harassment allegation that was **No Further Actioned (NFA)**. The reuse of this material for a new charge requires scrutiny of the original reporting tone, urgency, and content.
- 3. Existential Defence Rights As the defendant, I am entitled to access all material that may reasonably assist my defence or undermine the prosecution, as per CPIA 1996 and the Code of Practice.
- 4. **Public Interest and Safety** The call contains claims that police "are doing nothing." This may reflect procedural bias or misrepresentation that directly affects my safety and public perception. I must be able to rebut this with full context.

Specific Request

I request:

- The **full unredacted audio recording** of the 999 call
- A **transcript**, if available
- Any associated CAD notes or operator annotations

This material is critical to my defence and to exposing procedural contradictions that may otherwise remain obscured.
